Dear Parent/Carers

Exam season is well underway, and I have been impressed by the organisation and motivation of our students, the positive way they are dealing with their exams and the support they are giving to each other. Thank you to all our parents and carers who are behind the scenes, helping the students to be ready and providing that vital encouragement every day. The final exam is on Monday 16th June.

Optional Study Leave from 2nd June to 15th June

We realise that it is important for all students to manage their exams, their revision and their health. Teachers are providing guided revision sessions to help students be fully prepared for their exams and we would like students in lessons, using their time well. However, if you feel it is better for your child to be at home at any time that they do not have an exam we will grant study leave from 2nd June.

Please inform the office daily and liaise with transport providers if you wish to cancel any sessions or journeys. Please be aware that cancelled journeys cannot be moved to other times and any replacement journeys required will become the responsibility of parents and carers.

Parents must take responsibility for their child's journey if they are leaving school early, for instance after examinations, by either collecting their child or informing us that their child is authorised to leave school to travel independently.

Revision, activities and teacher support will continue to be provided to students who attend school for their timetabled sessions.

Exam And Revision Transport

Transport is booked to bring students into all examinations and revision sessions as indicated on your exam and revision timetable, up to and including Monday 16th June.
